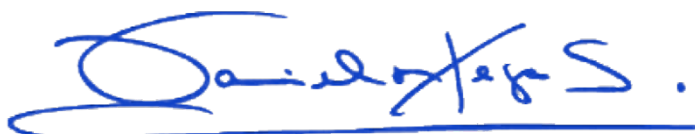
The path to Independence, Freedom and Prosperity for our Poeples is a challenging one and the
