

STATEMENT

**BY THE NICARAGUAN NATIONAL ASSEMBLY
IN A DIGNIFIED AND SOVEREIGN RESPONSE
TO COSTA RICAN MEMBERS OF PARLIAMENT**

We have learned, through the media, of the Letter that 52 Costa Rican Members of Parliament have sent to International Organizations, introducing political demands that evidently reflect xenophobic and racist positions, not for the first time manifested against Nicaragua, with an evident sense of discrimination and making unacceptable qualifications about our Institutions, our Country and our People in general. These are chauvinistic, not fraternal criteria and above all reflect an arrogance and sense of superiority, improper among the Central American Peoples.





Nicaragua has its own considerations on the internal problems of Costa Rica, and on its handling of each of the crises that its National Institutions have had to face, and are facing, but out of respect we do not get involved. *mv*

We denounce and reject those reiterated and offensive, arrogant, interventionist and shameless attitudes and declarations of Rightwing Costa Rican Members of Parliament, backward, conceited and presumptuous and which at all times and from fascist visions and practices, coincide with their subordination to the Empires.

Our Nicaragua, Dignified, Sovereign, Independent, Always Blessed and Always Free, has managed to confront, with Education and the Sentiments of a Central American Neighbor, each attack, in each circumstance, making clear at all



times, that we are not a Colony, or Nobody's subjects.

To pretend that the coup mongering, criminal, terrorist and failed Nicaraguan Opposition, and its NGO's, financed by Organizations at the imperial intervention centers, are the source and authority that governs our Nicaragua, is to continue seeking, in the XXI century, the absurd annexation of our San Juan River or of our Lakes to Costa Rica, and even reflect the insulting intention of turning our Beautiful City of Granada, Cultural Heritage of Humanity, into a Province of that colonialist and rapacious face of Costa Rica.

From what we can see, that voracious, devouring, usurpative and filibuster mentality continues to agitate and excite the Costa Rican Rightwing, with conceit of grandeur.



We are Nicaraguans by the Grace of God. We are not slaves to a fascist Right, which we disown. We do not accept your interference in our Internal Affairs. The 52 Member of Parliament, signatories to a shameful Manifesto of Adhesion to imperial interference, should take into consideration their own national miseries, reflected daily in their own Media, and seek to resolve their serious economic and social problems, instead of continuing to attack Nicaragua, which has not harmed and is not harming them, with such premeditated, treacherous and rabidly anti-patriotic political spite. 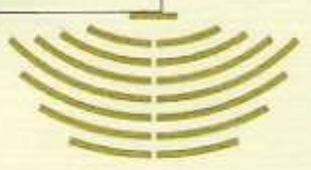

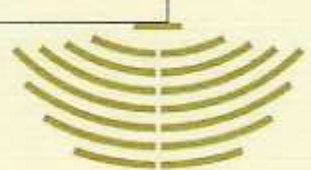
