Chancellor:

We have received your letter today that we consider to be unacceptable since you refer in offensive and insulting terms to Nicaraguan citizens by nationalization, a right that all the civilized States of the World have.

We want to remind you, without the intention of offending, that from your position as Chancellor, and rather taking advantage of it, you have meddled in the internal affairs of our Blessed and Always Free Nicaragua.

We have received from you, showing off your status as Chancellor of El Salvador, demands and hassles regarding the situation of your ex-spouse, citizen Arturo Cruz Sequeira, who has been accused and is being investigated for Treason, Money Laundering and other crimes.

We also know that your pressuring threats and blackmail have been extended to the scope of SICA, whose General Secretariat corresponds by right to Nicaragua, and where you are preventing through personal, inappropriate, incorrect and illegal behaviors, the required consensus, in flagrant violation of the Treaty of Tegucigalpa.

You, Madam Chancellor, know exactly what this complaint represents. You, Madam Chancellor, know that your behavior violates all the Ethical Codes corresponding to your position.

Mixing personal interests, blackmailing, threatening and obstructing the relations between States, for reasons beyond your official representation, constitutes a crime of usurpation, that must be investigated in your country. You know well what we mean, and you know what abuse of State functions represents in any Institutionalilty.

We are aware that you have seriously intruded and overstepped, demanding unacceptable preferences for your ex-spouse, Mr. Cruz Sequeira, for your own interests. You have even gone so far as to "threaten" to involve the United States in these matters that are of the National Sovereignty of Nicaragua. As you well know, this constitutes an unusual and

unjustifiable interference in our affairs of National Sovereignty.

**Chancellor:**

When yours is a glass roof, the smart thing is not to throw stones. You must answer for your interference as we will answer for our Sovereignty and Independence.

We are sure that the Salvadoran State will open the corresponding investigation for these crimes of abuse of power, threats, intimidation, blackmail and excesses, including the boastful reference to your own (As in Yourself) links with extra-regional governments, seeking precisely, to pressure in order to achieve their objectives of interference.

We remind you that we cannot be bribed, our fierce history reaffirms this.

On the other hand, and given so many evidences of conflict of interest, we cannot exclude, Mrs. Alexandra, your own involvement in anti-patriotic issues, harmful to our Sovereignty and other crimes already mentioned, for which your ex-husband, Arturo Cruz Sequeira, a citizen of Nicaragua, is the subject of a judicial investigation.

We await your answer.
